Local Law No. 1 Of the year 20 05

A local law to Amend Local Law #2 of 1974 and Local Law #1 of 1991, in
(Insert Title)
regard to Water Charges and Rates

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the
(Name of Legislative Body)

County
City
of Burdett as follows:

I. Section 14C of Local Law #2 of 1974, as amended by Local Law #1 of 1991, Continuing Service Rate Schedule, is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Meters shall be read, and water use shall be billed, bi-monthly rather than quarterly.

B. Over a three-year period, the water rates shall be increased according to the following schedule:

1. Commencing June 1, 2006, the first 10,000 gallons or less bi-monthly - \$46.67 (total of \$280.00 annually).
2. Commencing June 1, 2007, the first 10,000 gallons or less bi-monthly - \$63.33 (total of \$380.00 annually).
3. Commencing June 1, 2008, the first 10,000 gallons or less bi-monthly - \$80.00 (total of \$480.00 annually).

C. Any usage over the 10,000 gallon bi-monthly minimum, shall be billed at the following rates:

1. \$0.35 per 100 gallons for residential
2. \$0.45 per 100 gallons for commercial properties.

D. "Commercial properties" shall be defined as any residential property, other than a single family residence, which contains rental units; any business that requires permits, licenses, or pays sales tax; any other property clearly non-residential in nature; and any property having a real property tax code of 220 or higher.

II. Paragraph 14 of Local Law #2 of 1974, as amended by Local Law #1 of 1991, shall be further amended by addition of Subsection F. to read as follows:

F. At any time and from time-to-time, whenever the Board of Trustees of the Village of Burdett deems it necessary, prudent or advisable to change or increase the above specified water charges and rates, or any other charges or rates as set forth in paragraph 14, the Board of Trustees may do so upon written Resolution adopted by majority vote. It shall not be necessary to further amend this Local Law in order to change or increase water charges or rates.

III. Paragraph 14 of Local Law #2 of 1974, as amended by Local Law #1 of 1991, shall be further amended by addition of Subsection G. to read as follows:

G. Water bills shall only be issued in the name of the property owner as shown on the current Village Tax Roll. There shall be only a single meter per service line.

IV. This Local Law shall take effect on June 1, 2006.




